#### **Annual Report of 2017**

On January 1, the books received by Bangladesh government were distributed among the 113 children on the three campuses of the organization. The book distribution program was held at the Chayatal comer of Shyamoli Park in Dhaka. The program was organized from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. Some dignitaries of society and the volunteers of Chayatal Bangladesh were present program. Books had been distributed among the 45 first graders, 41 second graders, and 27 third grade students. It was observed that all the children were excited to get the new book.

The education scheme is conducted on three campuses daily from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on its own syllabus. The organization is trying to bring underprivileged children back into the mainstream of society. Volunteers are managing the project in a timely manner.




