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JOURNEY OF CHAYATAL

On 16th March 2016, Sohel Rana, the founder of Chayatal, sat contemplatively in the late afternoon under a small tree at one corner of Shyamoli Park. A street child named 'Rakib' approached him and asked for "Jhalmuri." Sohel Rana offered a condition: if the child could write his name, he would treat the child later. The child agreed happily and attempted to write his name, though he was unsuccessful. Sohel Rana encouraged the little boy to uplift his spirits. By the day's end, Sohel Rana bought the child "Jhalmuri." The following day, the child returned eager to learn to write his name and brought two more companions named Nodi and Smrity.

Sohel Rana was delighted to teach them how to write their names and was pleased that the children continued to come to him, with their numbers increasing day by day. At the end of the month, there were 16 children who hailed from the underprivileged segments of society. Sohel Rana, along with some university students, agreed to form an organization, naming it Chayatal Bangladesh, as it was born from the shade of trees on 16th March 2016. Since then, Chayatal has been dedicatedly working for the underprivileged children of society.



ABOUT CHAYATAL BANGLADESH

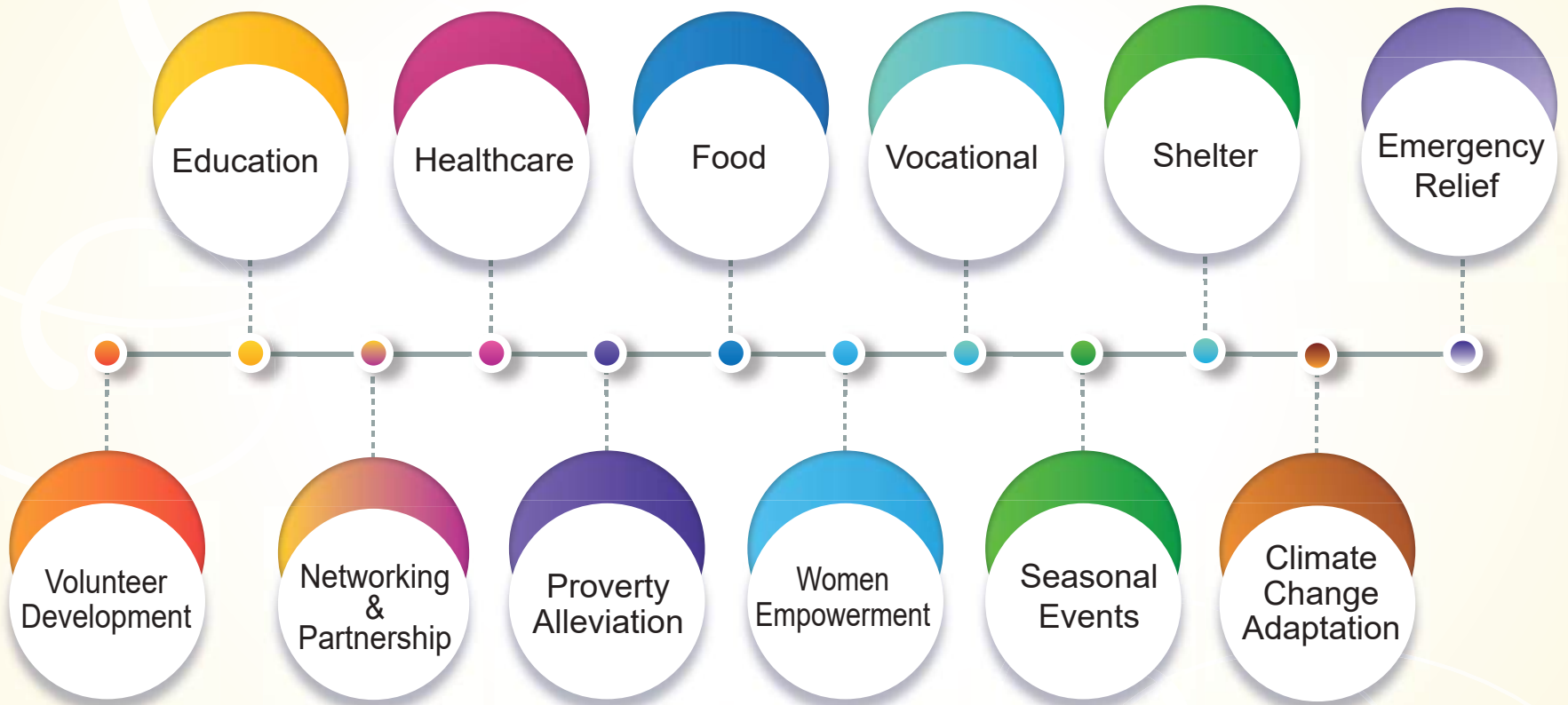
Chayatal Bangladesh is a nonprofit voluntary organization. (NGO Number: 3296). (Registration Number: 09807). Our goal is to improve the lives of underprivileged street children in Bangladesh. We would like to do some constructive work for underprivileged children. Through mentorship, vocational training, and after-school programs, Chayatal Bangladesh empowers children with knowledge, skills, and confidence, helping them break free from the cycle of poverty and build a better future for themselves and their families. Chayatal is working with a motto “we don’t want a single child to grow up on the street”

The activities we are undertaking are as follows:

- ◆ For the underprivileged children, we are running four campuses. Free Educational materials such as school bags, id cards, school uniforms, school keds including necessary clothes are provided.
- ◆ With a focus on the food pyramid, the volunteers of Chayatal Bangladesh cook nutritious meals for children and serve them in clay pots.
- ◆ Different types of job oriented training are provided including Sewing Machine, Handicraft, Spoken English Class, Mobile servicing and Computer Skill Development etc.
- ◆ Arranging free medical camp every month to ensure first aid to children and their families.
- ◆ Dancing, singing training, self defence training (karate) and religious education are provided.

By fostering a sense of hope, self-worth, and opportunity, Chayatal Bangladesh is transforming the lives of some of the most marginalized children in society, giving them the chance to dream, learn, and succeed.

FOCUS AREA



OUR MISSION

Our mission is to safeguard, preserve, and uphold the fundamental rights of underprivileged children and socially disadvantaged segments of the population, aiming to eradicate all forms of poverty and discrimination from society. We aspire to establish a secure society where children are healthy and well-educated. This will be achieved by offering essential educational resources and nutritional aid to underprivileged children, as well as by generating employment opportunities and providing vocational training in areas such as sewing, mobile repairing, and computer skills.

OUR VISION

Residential School & College : Our vision is to build a shelter home for the children to study permanently in their own campus. We are currently running our education program up to the secondary level. Later, We will take the education program from secondary to higher secondary level.

University: For higher education We have taken steps to create our own university. There Chayatal's own students as well as the students of the country can receive higher education, this long-term plan is moving towards implementation.

Oldage Home: Family members often fail to care for the elderly. Keeping all these problems in mind, Chayatal Bangladesh is planning to open an old age home.

Hospital: Another step is to build a hospital by thinking about the underprivileged people of the society. As a result, Chayatal Bangladesh is moving forward with the goal that the poor people of the society get proper medical care.

Chayatal Bank: Chayatal Bank PLC aims to empower communities with inclusive banking solutions, focusing on innovation, sustainability, and social impact.

I never anticipated that my path would intersect with that street children until a boy named Rakib approached me, requesting five taka to purchase Jhalmuri. His disheveled appearance spoke volumes about the hostile environment in which he was growing up. Chayatal Bangladesh was born from the simple act of teaching Rakib to write with chalk. Presently, our organization has positively impacted the lives of approximately three hundred children, striving to meet every aspect of their developmental needs. Despite our efforts, providing shelter—a fundamental necessity for a child's safety and growth—remains a challenge. My aspiration is to establish a residential facility where these children can thrive in a secure environment. We endeavor to equip them with vocational skills, empowering them to become self-reliant. The dedicated volunteers of Chayatal Bangladesh work tirelessly towards this cause. I extend an invitation to compassionate individuals to join us in supporting at least one child's expenses, thereby preventing any child from enduring the hardships of street life. I invite you to become a part of Chayatal Bangladesh as its founder.

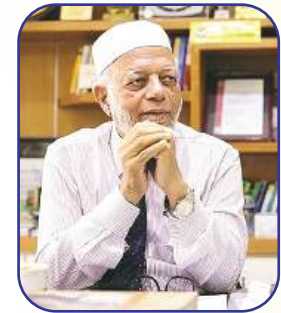

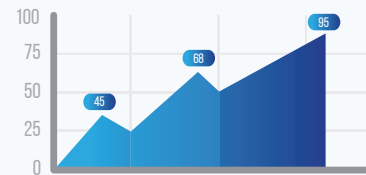
Since 2016, Chayatal Bangladesh has been working to remove barriers to education, making it accessible and creating an educated population. Its core motto is:
"We do not want a single child to grow up on the streets."



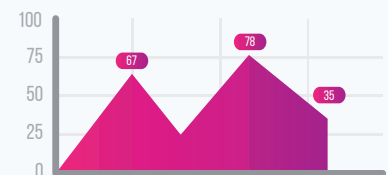

FOOD & NUTRITION

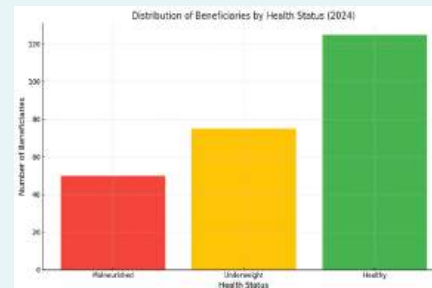
In a world ruled by hunger, life loses its poetic essence.

Considering children's health and nutritional needs, Chayatal Bangladesh ensures food security by providing free breakfast, snacks, and lunch to its students.

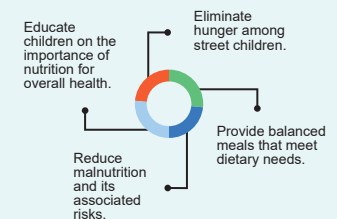

HEALTH & CARE

Chayatal Bangladesh is very conscious about children's health and treatment. We do not want a children to be deprived of medical care. To ensure children's good health Chayatal Bangladesh arrange a monthly medical camp as well as we provide them free medical, sanitary napkins and many other nessary things. Specially for teenage girls, students, we pay extra attention for their health and treatment which they take totally free.

Rickshaw Distribution: A Path to Livelihood

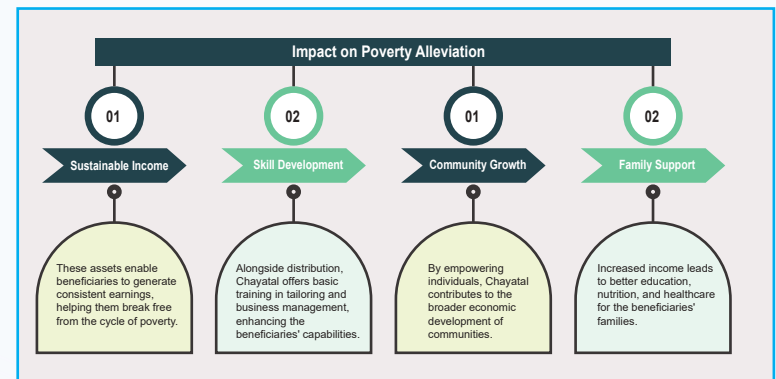

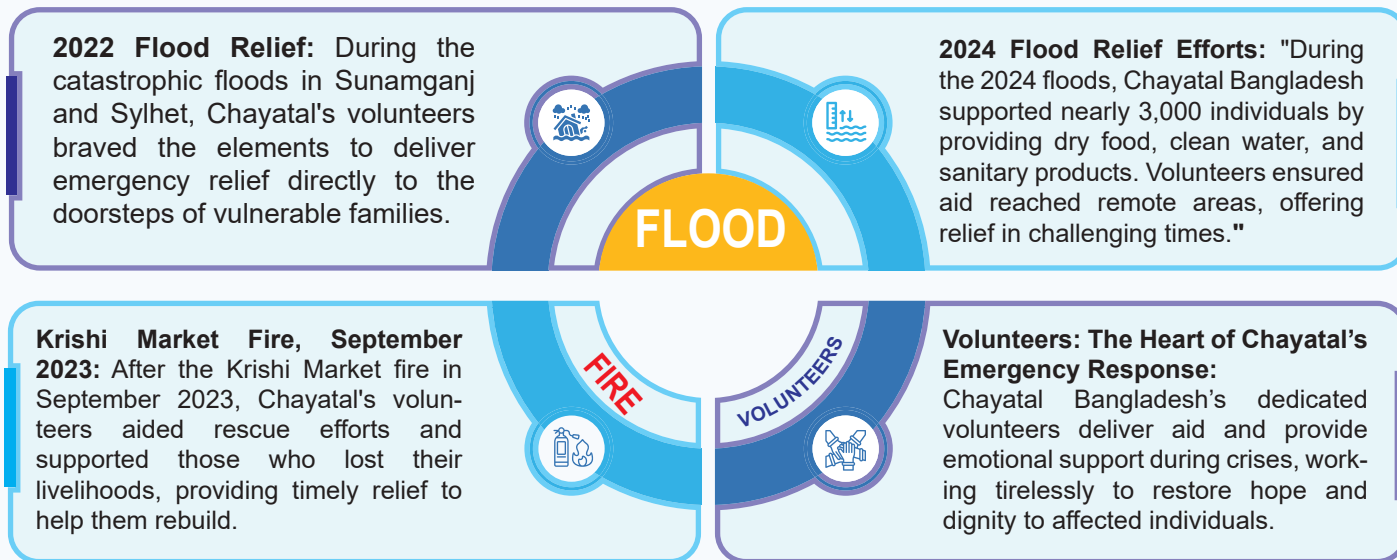

Winter Health Protection Campaigns

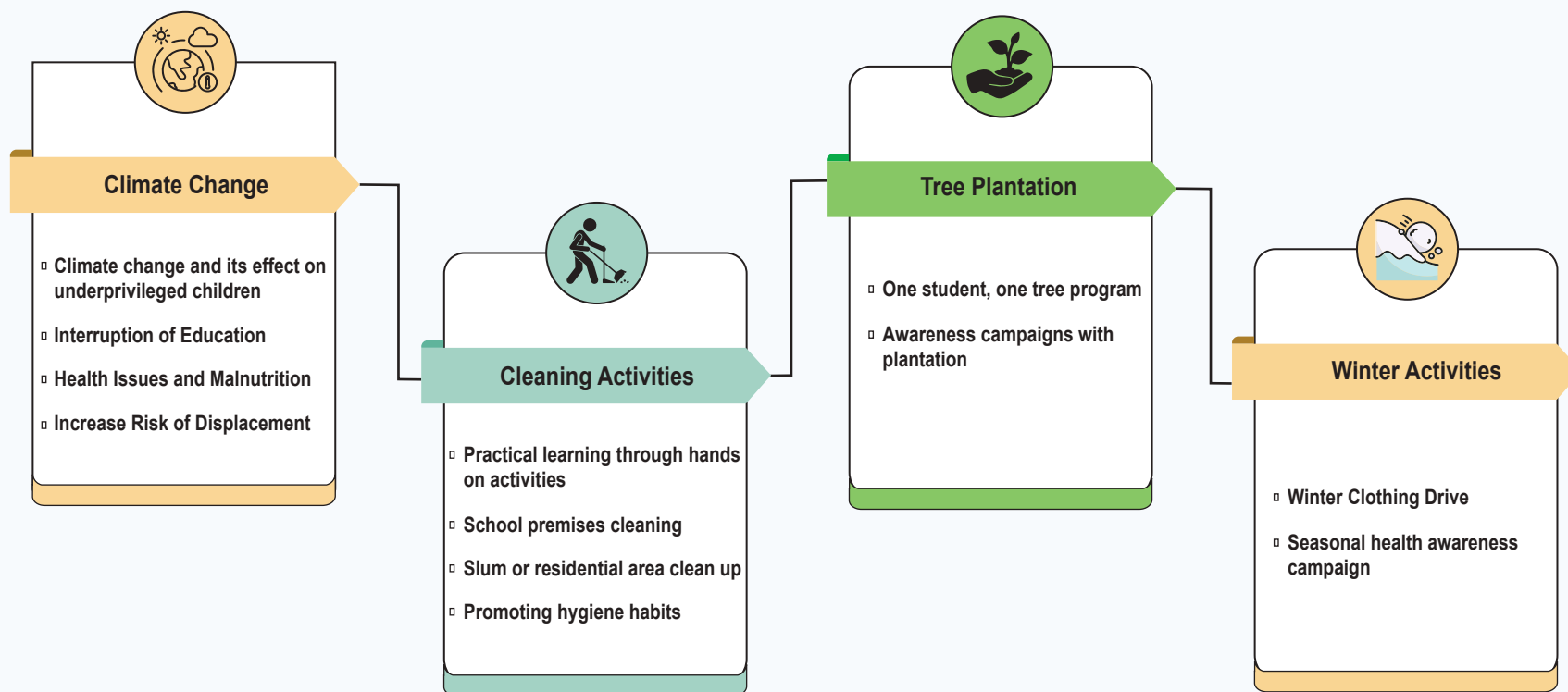

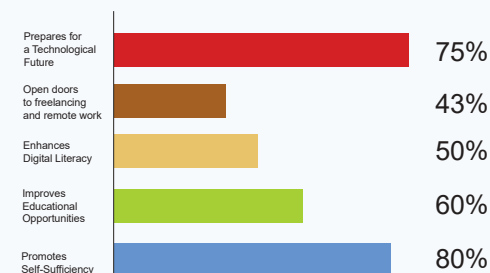

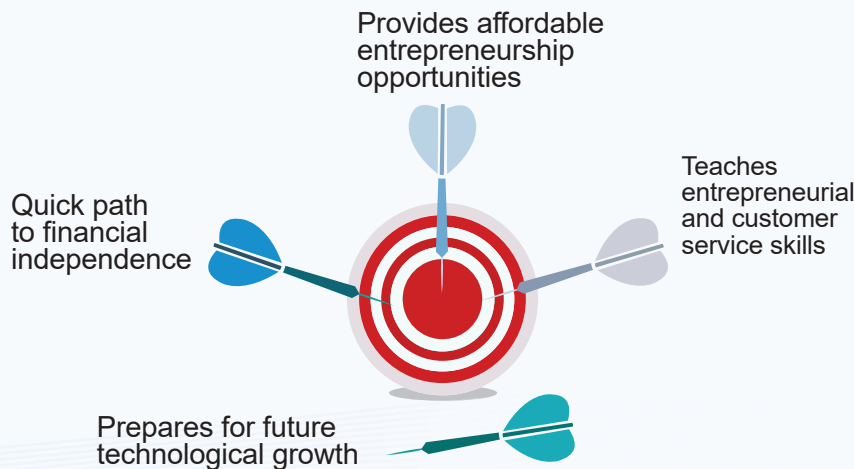
Success Rate of Computer Training



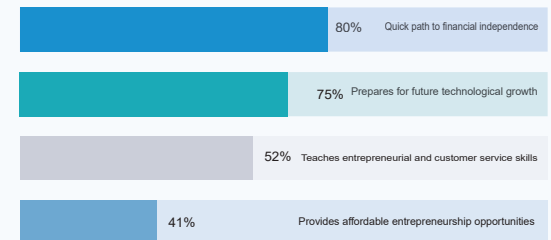


Mobile Repairing Training

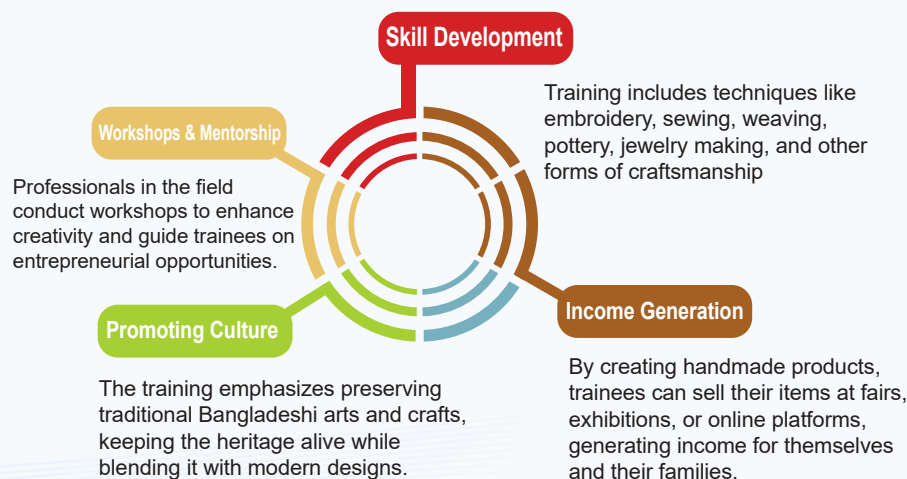
Success Rate of Mobile Repairing Training



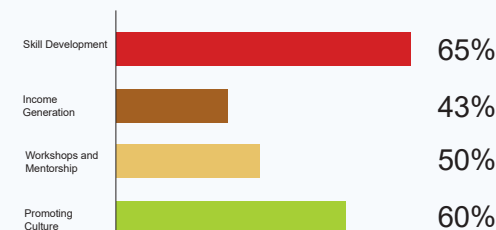


Handicraft Training

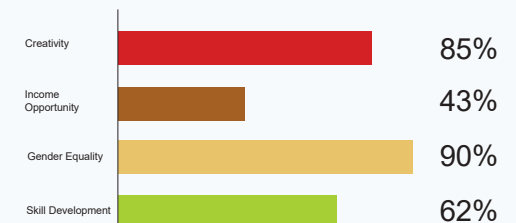

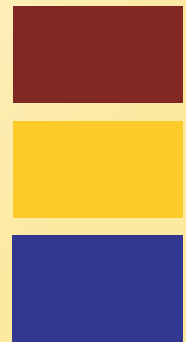

The present study focused on the role of handicraft area, their experiences and the role of handicraft business as a tool of empowerment.

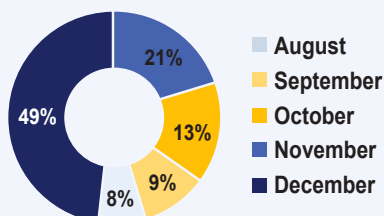

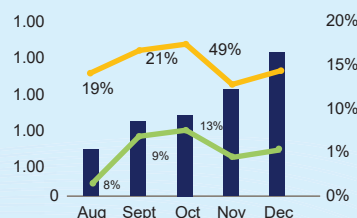

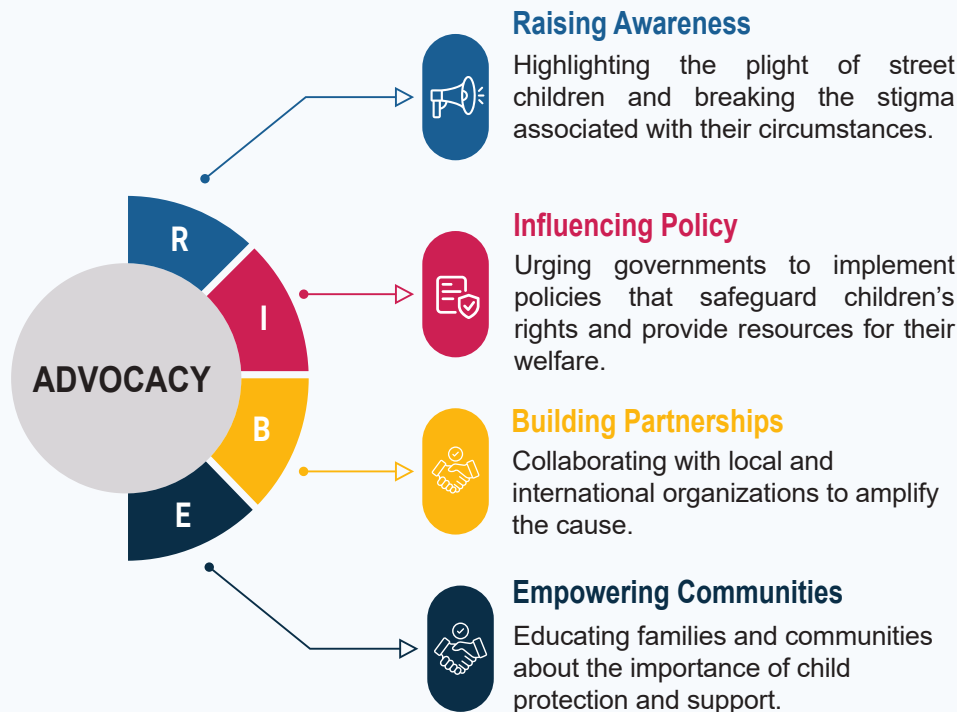




ADVOCACY

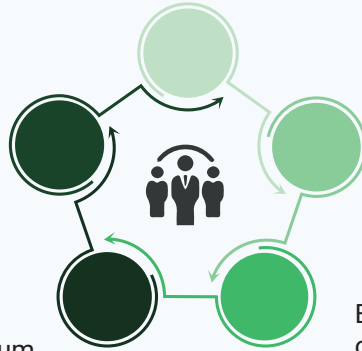

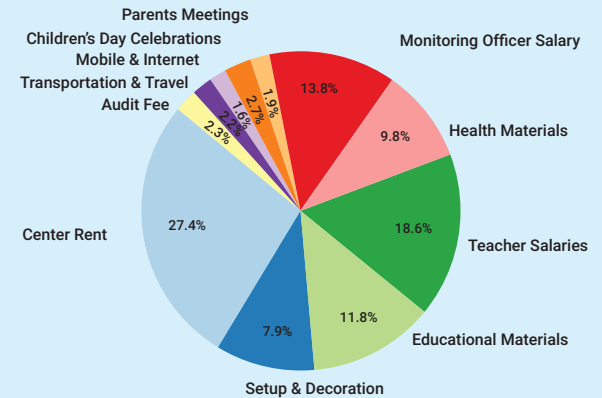

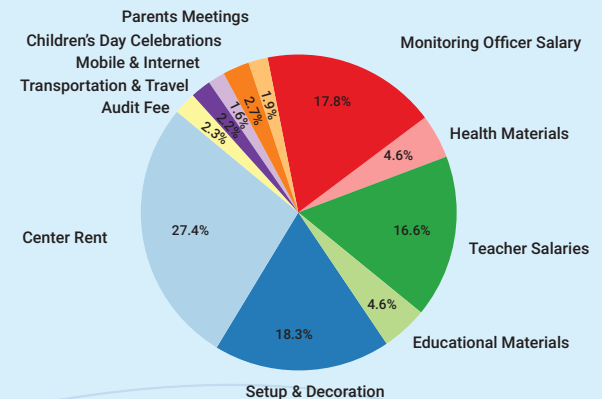

BACHAO PROJECT

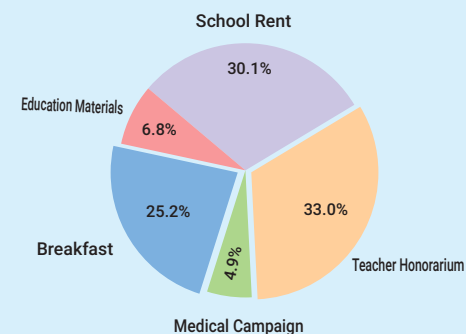
